Kick-off speech: Professor Yoshihiro Takiguchi, President, TAK System Initiative Corporation



Professor Yoshihiro Takiguchi studied Nuclear Engineering during his Bachelor and Master degrees at Nagoya University. Subsequently, he joined Hamamatsu Photonics K.K. as a researcher working for ultrafast laser and detection projects. Hamamatsu sent him to The City College of New York (CCNY) for a collaborate operation of "Photonic Application Laboratory". After he came back to Hamamatsu, he worked for several national projects including "Quantum Fluctuation" project at the Japanese Agency for Science and Technology and the Japanese Air and Space Agency to promote Space application of Photonics. He started working at the Graduate School for the

Creation of New Photonics Industries (GPI) as a professor to teach students from companies to train them to be a business leader for each section of industrial fields. He also founded his own company TAK System Initiative Corporation to boost new photonics businesses and was assigned as vice president for international collaboration from the GPI.
